Green Initiatives:

Use of Bamboo Tees:

- Bamboo is a renewable resource
- Ready for harvest in only 4 years compared to a typical hardwood tree maturation of 40 years
- The natural starches in bamboo help it decompose quickly

Re-Use Water for Irrigation:

- First permitted for reuse water in Connecticut

Integrated Turf & Pest Management Plan:

- Limit our use of chemicals on the golf course
- Use organic fertilizers whenever possible

Water Quality & Wetland Monitoring

We recycle all paper, cardboard, plastic bottle and cans

Use of touch-less paper towel dispensers
